A union's constitution establishes the fundamental rules that govern the union. It also helps to protect the rights of union members.

A union local constitution serves as a set of governing rules and guidelines specific to a particular local branch of a labor union, outlining the rights, responsibilities, and procedures for its members, including how the local union will operate, elect officers, manage finances, and address grievances within the specific workplace it represents, ensuring democratic practices and upholding the broader principles of AFSCME International.

The Constitution Committee, at the March meeting, shall submit to the membership for discussion, review, revision and a vote for approval the Local's newly written Constitution. The Constitution contains bylaws and provisions by which Local 1326 shall be governed.
