TO ALL WFSE LOCAL UNION PRESIDENTS AND SECRETARIES:

The 48th Biennial Convention of the Washington Federation of State Employees, Council 28 AFSCME AFL-CIO, will be held in SeaTac, Washington at the Doubletree Hotel Seattle Airport (19740 International Blvd, Seattle, WA 98188) on Friday-Saturday, October 4-6, 2019.

The Convention will begin on Friday, October 4, at 1: 00pm. Convention Committee meetings will be held on Thursday October 3, 2019, beginning at 4:00pm. The following committees that will meet (if necessary): Constitution and Bylaws, Credentials, Elections, Legislative Officer Reports, PEOPLE, Resolutions, Rules, and Sergeant-at-Arms. All Committee members shall be notified thirty (30) days prior to the convening of the Convention in writing of committee appointments made by the Council President.

This Convention is called in accordance with Article VII-Meetings, Section 1, of the Council Constitution which states:

“The Council Biennial Convention shall be held in odd-numbered years and on a Saturday and Sunday in September or October but may also be convened on the preceding Friday. The call to the biennial Convention shall be issues at least 120 days preceding the commencement of the Convention. The Council 28 Executive Board shall select the Convention dates and city.”

REGISTRATION

Onsite registration will be open on Thursday, October 3 from 12:00pm to 6:00pm, and on Friday, October 4 from 8:00am to 4:00pm, and Saturday, October 5 from 7:30am to 9:00am. The Convention fee is \$75.00 per delegate and/or alternate attending and must be pre-paid by check at the time the credentials are returned to WFSE Headquarters office.

GUESTS

The cost of guest tickets for the Friday evening banquet is \$45.00 per person. Banquet tickets for guests must be purchased by 5:00pm on Friday, October 4.
